



Writers include an MLA Works Cited list at the end of essays and research papers to indicate what sources they've used in their papers. The following are a few *representative examples* based on the *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers, 7th ed., LB2369.G53 2009*. The MLA Handbook should be your final authority regarding proper citation format.

MLA Works Cited in general

Author's last name, first name. *Title*. Publication information including date. Media.

The first line of each entry in your list must be flush left with the margin. Subsequent lines in each entry should be indented one-half inch. **Double-space all entries.** Alphabetize all entries into one list.

No author

One author

Heinlein, Robert A. *Stranger in a Strange Land*. New York: Putnam, 1991. Print.

Editor

Leiter, Richard A., ed. *National Survey of State Laws*. Detroit : Thomson, 2008. Print.

Two or three authors

Lewis, Thomas, Fari Amini, and Richard Lannon. *A General Theory of Love*. New York: Random, 2000. Print.

More than three authors

Kay, John P., et al. *A History of World Societies*. 8th ed. Boston: Bedford/St. Martin, 2009. Print.

Author and editor

Burns, Robert. *Burns: Poems*. Ed. Gerard Carruthers. New York: Knopf, 2007. Print.

Edition (not the first or revised edition)

Wright, D. Franklin. *Prealgebra: A Worktext*. 2nd ed. Boston: Houghton, 1997. Print.

Play in a collection

Richards, Beah. "A Black Woman Speaks." *9 Plays by Black Women*. Ed. Margaret B. Wilkerson. New York: NAL, 1986. Print.

Multivolume Set (when using two or more volumes)

Newman, Roger K., ed. *The Constitution and Its Amendments*. 4 vols. New York: Macmillan Reference USA, 1999. Print.

Encyclopedia article

"Crime Mapping." *Encyclopedia of Police Science*. Ed. Jack R. Greene. New York: Routledge, 2007. Print.

Essay, poem or short story in an anthology
